**QUEEN ANNE** is an early maturing variety with a high marketable yield. This variety produces yellow fleshed tubers with smooth, bright-yellow skin. Among other qualities, Queen Anne shows excellent resistances to Rhizoctonia, bruising, and common scab. This variety is suitable for organic growing.
